ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL


On October 2, 2014 the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* ("*Motion*"), along with supporting documentation, seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt via administrative wage garnishment "because HUD's Financial Operations Center has confirmed that Petitioner is currently unemployed." (See *Motion*, Ex. A, Declaration of Kathleen M. Porter, ¶ 3.)

Upon due consideration, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**.

The stay of referral shall remain in place indefinitely. However, HUD shall reserve the right to seek collection of the subject debt via alternative means, and may resume administrative wage garnishment activities in the future should Petitioner resume employment.

This matter of HUDOHA #14-VH-0130-AG-051 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
