DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO SETTLEMENT WITH RESPONDENT WALTON


On June 23, 2015, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (the Government) filed a *Complaint* against Respondents Alisha Royster, Kim Walton, and Luveria Royster alleging a total of 26 false claims and seeking the imposition of civil penalties and assessments totaling \$213,699.00, jointly and severally, pursuant to the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3801-3812, and 24 C.F.R. Part 28.

Thereafter the Government and Respondents Luveria Royster and Alisha Royster engaged in settlement discussions that resulted in settlement agreements resolving all issues in the matter as they relate to Respondents Luveria Royster and Alisha Royster. As a result, the Court dismissed the matter against Respondents Luveria Royster and Alisha Royster, leaving Kim Walton as the sole remaining Respondent.

On January 5, 2016, the Government moved to dismiss the matter as it pertains to Respondent Walton on the basis that the Government and Respondent Walton have also reached a settlement.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Government's *Motion* will be **GRANTED** and the matter against Respondent Walton will be **DISMISSED**.
