ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On November 25, 2014, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* ("*Motion*"), along with supporting documentation, seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt via administrative wage garnishment because garnishment of Petitioner's wages, at this time, would cause Petitioner financial hardship. (See Motion, Ex. A, Declaration of Brian Dillon.) Upon due consideration, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall retain the right to seek collection of the subject debt via alternative means, i.e. administrative offset, and may resume administrative wage garnishment activities in the future should Petitioner's financial circumstances improve.

The stay of referral shall remain in place indefinitely.
