
ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On March 20, 2015, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* ("Motion"), along with supporting documentation, seeking to dismiss without prejudice its action to pursue collection of the subject debt via administrative wage garnishment. The Secretary has determined that garnishment of Petitioner's wages, at this time, would cause Petitioner financial hardship. (See *Motion*, Ex. A, Declaration of Brian Dillon.) Upon due consideration, and for good cause, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall, however, retain the right to seek collection of the subject debt via alternative means, i.e. administrative offset, and may resume administrative wage garnishment activities in the future should Petitioner's financial circumstances improve.

The stay of referral shall remain in place indefinitely. This matter of HUDOHA No. 15-VH-0051-AG-016 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
