
ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On May 11, 2015, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* ("*Motion*"), along with supporting documentation, seeking to dismiss without prejudice its action to pursue collection of the subject debt via administrative wage garnishment. The Secretary has determined that garnishment of Petitioner's wages, at this time, would create undue financial hardship for Petitioner. (See Motion, Ex. A, Declaration of Brian Dillon.) Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall, however, retain the right to seek collection of the subject debt via alternative means, i.e. administrative offset, and may resume administrative wage garnishment activities in the future should Petitioner's financial circumstances improve. As such, the stay of referral issued on April 10, 2015 in the above-captioned matter is hereby **VACATED**.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 15-VH-0061-AG-022 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
