
RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 25, 2016, the Secretary filed the *Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss*, stating that "the Secretary and Petitioner have agreed that Petitioner's wages will be garnished by HUD to repay his debt." The Government further states that "... in order to avoid undue financial hardship to Petitioner, the garnishment amount will be reduced to \$600.00 per month."

Upon consideration of *The Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss*, and without objection, the motion is GRANTED. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED, *without prejudice*. The Stay of Referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury for collection, issued on February 24, 2016 is hereby VACATED.
