## **RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On December 13, 2016, this Court ordered Petitioner to file documentary evidence in support of his claim of financial hardship and his appeal, on or before January 16, 2017. Petitioner was also warned that:

Failure to comply with this Order shall result in the imposition of sanctions to include entry of judgment in favor of the Secretary in this case, a decision based on the documents of record, or other sanctions deemed necessary and appropriate by the Administrative Judge. See 24 C.F.R. §26.4(d).

Petitioner failed to file documentary evidence in support of his appeal or his claim of financial hardship, as required by the *December 13, 2016 Order*. On March 1, 2017, a *Show Cause Order* was issued against Petitioner ordering him to show cause, on or before March 15, 2017, why his appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. Again, Petitioner failed to comply with the *Show Cause Order*. Accordingly, Petitioner's appeal is DISMISSED, *sua sponte*. It is

**ORDERED** that Petitioner's appeal and Request for Hearing are DISMISSED, without prejudice. It is

**FURTHER ORDERED**, that the *Stay of Referral* issued in this case on August 17, 2016, is hereby VACATED.
