RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On September 26, 2017, the Secretary filed the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss, stating that garnishment of Petitioner's wages "will cause the family financial hardship." Id, at ¶3. However, the Court notes that HUD has reserved its right to resume collection action on the alleged debt in this case "should Petitioner's financial circumstances improve or if Petitioner's spouse fail[] to pay the subject debt in accordance with the terms of the repayment agreement." Id.

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Secretary's motion, and without objection, the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Petitioner's appeal is hereby **DISMISSED**, without prejudice. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the *Stay of Referral* of this action to the U.S. Department of the Treasury for collection, entered in this case on August 22, 2017, is hereby **VACATED**.
