**RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On September 22, 2017, the Secretary moved to dismiss this case on the following grounds:


After reviewing Petitioner's financial information, HUD has determined that garnishment of Petitioner's wages, at this time, would cause Petitioner financial hardship. The Secretary, therefore, moves to dismiss this proceeding, without prejudice. HUD, however, reserves the right to seek collection of the subject debt via alternative means, e.g., Administrative Offset, and may resume Administrative Wage Garnishment activities in the future should Petitioner's financial circumstances improve. *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss*, ¶2. (emphasis added). For good cause shown, and without objection, the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* is GRANTED. It is

**ORDERED** that this case is **DISMISSED**, *without prejudice*. It is

**FURTHER ORDERED**, that the Stay of Referral imposed in this case on August 23, 2017 is hereby **VACATED**.
