**RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On October 5, 2017, the Secretary filed the *Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* ("the Secretary's Motion"). The Secretary seeks dismissal of this action on the grounds that "Petitioner and HUD have entered into a *Debt Resolution Repayment Agreement* [ ] whereby Petitioner has promised to make monthly payments in the agreed amount until her debt has been repaid in full." However, the Secretary:


retains the right to pursue administrative wage garnishment and other legally available means of collection, should Petitioner fail to pay pursuant to the Agreement, or should future circumstances frustrate or terminate the Agreement and Petitioner's debt to HUD remains outstanding.

*The Secretary's Motion.* UPON CONSIDERATION of the *Secretary's Motion*, the motion is GRANTED. Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED** that this appeal is **DISMISSED**, *without prejudice*. It is

**FURTHER ORDERED** that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on September 5, 2017 is hereby **VACATED**.
