RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On September 5, 2017, Petitioner was ordered to file documentary evidence on or before October 5, 2017, to support his appeal in this case. *Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral,* dated September 5, 2017. Petitioner failed to comply with that *Order*.

On November 27, 2017, Petitioner was again ordered to file, on or before January 11, 2018, "documentary evidence which will prove that all or part of the alleged debt is either unenforceable or not past due." *Order*, dated November 27, 2017. Petitioner also failed to comply with the November 27th *Order*.

On January 24, 2018, the Office of Hearings and Appeals ("OHA") issued an *Order To Show Cause* ("*Show Cause*"). The *Show Cause* asked Petitioner to respond by February 24, 2018, and provide evidence as to why Petitioner's appeal should not be dismissed with judgment being entered in favor of the Secretary on the grounds that Petitioner has failed to comply with the Court's *Orders* in this case. Petitioner failed to respond to the *Show Cause*. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that this appeal is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on September 5, 2017 is hereby **VACATED**.
