ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On September 11, 2017, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* and documentary evidence seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment. The Secretary stated that, "On September 11, 2017, Petitioner entered into a voluntary repayment agreement with HUD's Financial Operations Center wherein he agreed to pay \$400.00 per month until his debt in the amount of \$33,880.21 plus continuing interest is paid in full. Declaration of Brian Dillon at ¶ 3 – Exhibit A." Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall retain the right to resume debt collection activities in the future, by means of administrative wage garnishment, or otherwise, should Petitioner fail to adhere to the terms of the Agreement. The stay of referral shall remain in place unless Petitioner fails to adhere to the terms of the Agreement.

The matter of HUDOHA #17-VH-0148-AG-038 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
