ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On August 18, 2017, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because Petitioner “is no longer employed.” Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall retain the right to resume debt collection activities in the future, by means of administrative wage garnishment or via alternative means, i.e., Administrative Offset, should Petitioner’s employment status change in the future.

The stay of referral shall remain in place until such time as Petitioner’s employment status changes.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 17-VH-0154-AG-040 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
