## RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 18, 2018, the Court issued an *Order for Documentary Evidence* requiring Petitioner to file documentary evidence in support of his position on or before January 8, 2019. On December 21, 2018, Petitioner filed a letter in response to the *Order*, stating:

We hereby acknowledge that the debt associated with Claim #721009688 is ours. Currently, this claim is being serviced by the Department of Treasury. Treasury records indicate the claim balance is \$33,986.21. My wages are currently being garnished on a bi-weekly basis in the amount of \$202.22. To date, our balance has been credited \$5,257.72. Based on Treasury's information provided, it is estimated that at the current payment schedule our balance will be paid off in approximately 6.5 years. We will do our due diligence towards fully repaying this loan.

Petitioner's Letter. Based on the foregoing admissions by Petitioner, the Court finds that Petitioner is indebted to the Department in the amounts claimed by the Secretary. The Court further finds that there are no other genuine issues of material fact remaining in dispute in this case. Accordingly, the Court rules, sua sponte, that Petitioner's appeal shall be dismissed. It is

**ORDERED** that this case is DISMISSED, without prejudice. It is

**FURTHER ORDERED** that the Stay of Referral entered in this case on or about October 11, 2017 is hereby VACATED.
