## RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On July 18, 2018, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* ("*Motion*"). The Secretary states that:

[a]fter reviewing Petitioner's biweekly pay statement, HUD has determined that her wages do not meet the minimum amount required for wage garnishment. Therefore wage garnishment is not permissible at this time. See 24 C.F.R. §285.11(i)(2)(i)(B). Accordingly, while the Secretary continues to assert that Petitioner's debt is past due and legally enforceable, the Secretary moves to dismiss this administrative wage garnishment proceeding without prejudice. (Declaration of Brian Dillon at ¶6 - Exhibit A).

UPON CONSIDERATION of the *Motion to Dismiss*, the motion is GRANTED. Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED** that this appeal is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice. It is
