**ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL**


On November 14, 2017, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because "HUD has determined that his wages do not meet the minimum amount required for wage garnishment." Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall retain the right to seek debt collection in the future, by alternative means (i.e. administrative offset) or by means of administrative wage garnishment, should Petitioner's wages increase at that time.

The stay of referral shall remain in place until such time as Petitioner's wages increase and meet the minimum amount as required.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 18-VH-0043-AG-025 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
