**ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL**


On March 15, 2018, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because Petitioner “has been involuntarily separated from employment.”

Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**. HUD shall retain the right to resume debt collection activities in the future, by means of administrative wage garnishment, should Petitioner become reemployed for 12 consecutive months.

The stay of referral shall remain in place until such time as Petitioner’s employment status changes.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 18-VH-0135-AG-071 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
