
**ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL**

On September 15, 2017, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss (Motion)* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, the above-captioned matter because the Secretary has determined that “the debt collection is not legally enforceable against Petitioner at this time because the Petitioner filed a Chapter 13 Bankruptcy Petition before the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Southern District of Ohio, on August 10, 2018. The Petitioner’s bankruptcy matter is currently active and pending.”

Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**. HUD shall retain the right to resume debt collection activities in the future, by means of administrative wage garnishment, or otherwise, should her bankruptcy case be dismissed or the debt owed to HUD not be discharged for any reason. The stay of referral in this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury shall remain in place pending the outcome of Petitioner’s bankruptcy case.

The matter of HUDOHA # 18-VH-0206-AG-107 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
