ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

NOW COMES BEFORE the Court a Motion to Dismiss filed by the Secretary on October 11, 2018 seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because, "After due consideration of Petitioner's financial circumstances, the Secretary has determined, although the debt owed to HUD is past due and enforceable, garnishment of Petitioner's wages at this time would create undue financial hardship."
