

RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On June 5, 2019, the Secretary filed the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* (the "Motion"). The Secretary seeks a dismissal of this case on the grounds that the U.S. Department of the Treasury interpreted Petitioner's request for loan documentation as Petitioner's *Request for Hearing*. The Treasury Department, therefore, inadvertently sought to have an appeal docketed on behalf of Petitioner. The *Motion*, ¶ 2. Moreover, the Secretary states that Petitioner has expressly stated that she does not desire to appeal the Secretary's determination that she is indebted to the Department as claimed by the Secretary. Based on the Secretary's representations to the Court, the Secretary's *Motion* will be GRANTED. It is

ORDERED that, Petitioner's appeal is DISMISSED, *with prejudice*, and the *Stay of Referral* of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury for collection, entered in this case on May 13, 2019, is hereby **VACATED**.
