RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On July 30, 2019, this Court ordered Petitioner to file documentary evidence on or before September 13, 2019, in support of Petitioner's appeal. *Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral*, dated July 30, 2019. In the *Hearing Request*, Petitioner stated that the debt was not owed, but provided no explanation or evidence whatsoever in support of the denial. Subsequent to the issuance of the *Notice of Docketing* on July 30, 2019, Petitioner failed to come forward with any documentary evidence to support the appeal. Petitioner, having failed to comply with the *Notice of Docketing*, leaves this Court without evidence to consider Petitioner's case.

This appeal thus fails for want of prosecution. Petitioner's appeal is DISMISSED, *sua sponte*. It is

ORDERED that Petitioner's appeal is hereby **DISMISSED**, *without prejudice*. The Stay of Referral to the U.S. Department of the Treasury entered on July 30, 2019, is **VACATED**.
