NOW COMES BEFORE THE COURT a *Motion to Dismiss* and documentary evidence, filed on June 19, 2019, by the Secretary to dismiss, without prejudice, collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment.

HUD shall retain the right to pursue all legally available means of debt collection against Petitioner, should he fail to pay pursuant to the Agreement, or should future circumstances frustrate or terminate the Agreement and Petitioner's debt to HUD remains outstanding. It is hereby

ORDERED that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on May 30, 2019, is VACATED.
