ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

NOW COMES BEFORE THE COURT a *Motion to Dismiss* and documentary evidence, filed on June 25, 2019, by the Secretary, to dismiss, without prejudice, collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment. The Secretary has determined that “garnishing [Petitioner’s] wages at this time would cause Petitioner financial hardship.”

Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the Secretary’s *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall reserve the right to resume debt collection activities, by means of administrative wage garnishment or via alternative means such as administrative offset, should Petitioner’s financial circumstances change in the future.

The stay of referral issued on June 13, 2019, shall remain intact unless otherwise determined that Petitioner’s financial circumstances have changed.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 19-VH-0137-AG-033 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
