NOW COMES BEFORE THE COURT, on February 25, 2020, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment. The Secretary has determined that "Based on the debt balance, the nominal amount of the potential garnishment, and Petitioner's financial circumstances, the Secretary moves to dismiss this proceeding, without prejudice, at this time."


Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

The stay of referral issued on January 10, 2020 by *Notice of Docketing* is hereby VACATED shall it be determined in the future that Petitioner's financial circumstances have otherwise improved.
