ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On September 15, 2020, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because the Secretary has determined that “After reviewing Petitioner's biweekly pay statement, HUD has determined that her wages do not meet the minimum amount required for wage garnishment. Therefore, wage garnishment is not permissible at this time.”


Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall reserve the right to resume debt collection activities, by means of administrative wage garnishment or via alternative means such as administrative offset, should Petitioner's financial circumstances improve in the future.

The stay of referral issued on April 3, 2020 by *Notice of Docketing* is hereby VACATED shall it be determined in the future that Petitioner's minimum amount required for wage garnishment is otherwise met.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 20-VH-0143-AG-079 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
