What's New in 9.1?

- Changes from the previous (September 14, 2009) release:
 - Added Unit code along with unit address for the tenant address in the Household Income Reports.
 - Removed statistics from the Identity Verification Reports.
 - New more powerful database backend with Oracle software (technical detail).

What's New in 9.1? (cont)

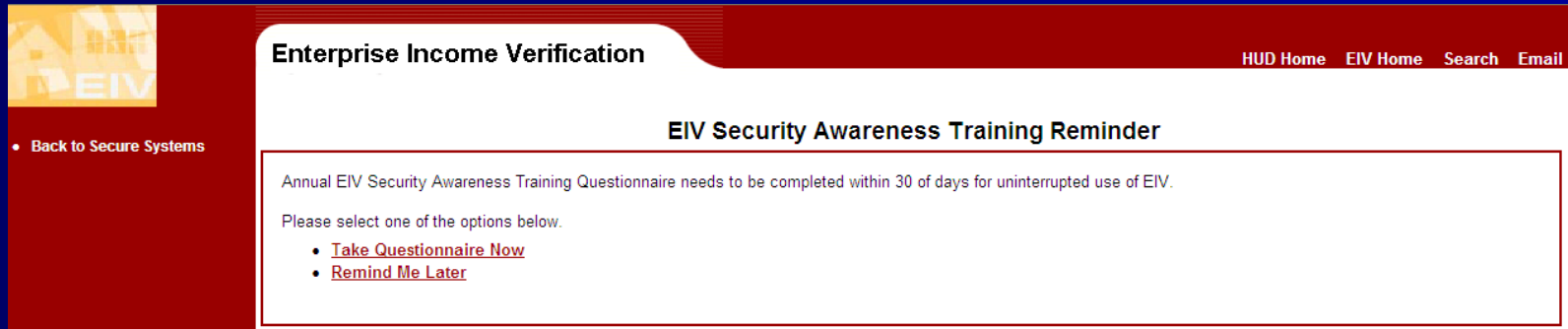
– EIV Security Test

- Starting on 4/19/2010, users who are nearing the anniversary date of the last security test will have 30 days to take and pass the security test. During the 30-day period, when logging in, users will be reminded to take the test EIV.
- Users will need to take the test once a year.
- New users will have to pass the test before accessing EIV.

What's New in 9.1? (Cont)

EIV Security Test – Reminder Option

Users who are nearing the anniversary date of the last security test will have 30 days to take and pass the security test.
