Units Capital Advance

The Fiscal Year 1991 Appropriations Act requires that 500 units of the total units available for supportive housing for persons with disabilities be used to provide housing for persons who are disabled as a result of infection with the Human Acquired Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV). Accordingly, sponsors are invited to submit applications proposing housing to serve persons with disabilities resulting from an infection with the HIV. Such applications must be in accordance with program requirements (such as unit limits) for housing for persons with disabilities.
