WHEREAS, under the Section 811 Program for Supportive Housing for Persons with Disabilities, the Sponsor is required to make a commitment to cover the estimated start-up expenses, the minimum capital investment of 1/2 of one percent of the HUD-approved capital advance, not to exceed \$10,000, and any amenities or features not covered by the capital advance.
