2. Summary. This handbook describes the procedures for
administering Indian HOME Program grants. The information

processing procedures, and guidelines are intended to
provide uniformity throughout the grant program to enhance
the efficiency of operations as well as establishing
standard operating procedures in one comprehensive document.
The portion of the grant program's life cycle covered by
this handbook starts with submission of a grant application
by an applicant to the local Field Office of Native American
Programs in response to a Notice of Funding Availability
(NOFA) issued by Headquarters and continues through closeout
of the grant agreement between HUD and a grantee.
