Summary Requirements and Description		
	Requirement	Description
1	HQs Management Report	Provides high-level summary report on the number and percent of contracts/projects that have access to EIV.
2	Identity Verification Report/ Failed Verification Report	Makes the Failed Verification Report accessible via the Identity Verification Report under the Verification Report function.
3	Confirmation of Third Party Verification Page	Provides confirmation of online, independent third party verification requests. Specifies household information, third party income sources, date of third party verification, and User ID requesting independent third party verification.
4	User Name and Partial User ID on Printable and Online Reports	Adds user identification information to all online and printable reports.
5	EIV – Legal Warning Page	Adds affirmation statement for HUD staff performing contract administrator (CA) functions.
6	User Requests	Provides the ability for EIV Coordinators to sort EIV User online User Access Authorization Form (UAAF) requests by date received.
7	Authorization Form & Authorization Requests	Makes names of links consistent and corrects the name of the actual form and type of action being performed.
8	Existing Tenant Search	Provides updated confirmation message that no results (match) were found in PIH or MFH programs for searched Social Security Numbers (SSNs).
9	User Certification	Provides the capability to search for an internal user by User ID.
10	User Session and Activity Audit Report	Provides the capability for User Administrators to sort by User ID, First Name, and Last Name
11	User Maintenance	Changes action terminology from “Expiration...” to “Termination...”
12	New DTI-MFH User – Disaster Tenant Information Role	Creates a new role for HUD staff implementing disaster programs to search for individuals who may be receiving HUD subsidy.
