

At 2 pm Eastern Daylight Savings Time on Tuesday, October 27, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), Office of Public and Indian Housing, will be conducting a satellite broadcast on the Housing and Urban Development – Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (HUD-VASH) program.

The October 27 HUD-VASH broadcast is intended for Public Housing Agencies (PHAs) and Veterans Affairs Medical Centers (VAMCs) partners that are administering the HUD-VASH program and for HUD field office staff. Where HUD-VASH participants have moved under portability billing arrangements to the jurisdictions of PHAs that are not participating in HUD-VASH, the receiving PHAs should also be encouraged to participate.

The broadcast will address a variety of issues that should be of interest to both established HUD-VASH programs and new sites that are just implementing programs. Topics to be covered will include the HUD operating requirements, portability, reporting, project-basing, administrative fees, VA case management and potential resources available through the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing program. Viewers of the live broadcast will have the chance to ask questions.
