SUBJECT: 1990 Annual Leave Restoration

This responds to your request for a legal opinion regarding the denial of your request for restoration of annual leave. Specifically, you requested that we review the decision rendered by the Office of Personnel and Training (OPT).

According to OPT, you submitted a written request for use of annual leave for the period of December 20, 1990 to January 14, 1991. Excluding holidays, this period represented a total of 108 hours of annual leave. Due to an exigency of the public business, use of the scheduled annual leave was canceled. Based on your request for restoration of leave, this leave was restored to your account. You now request that the 4 hours of holiday leave that resulted from the half-day holiday declared by President Bush on December 24, 1990 be restored to your annual leave account.

After reviewing your request, we find no legal basis for restoring the 4 hours of annual leave forfeited as a result of the half-day holiday declared on December 24, 1990.
