Description: Federal Housing Administration (FHA) representatives from the Philadelphia Homeownership Center will conduct this live, instructor-led session in Boston, MA, which will provide an overview of the appraisal requirements outlined in the *Single Family Housing Policy Handbook* 4000.1 (SF Handbook). Topics include: property inspection requirements; appraisal validity period; manufactured homes; water and septic; attic and crawl space inspections; and the FHA Appraiser Roster. This session is free and open to all interested stakeholders. FHA appraisers, underwriters, and lender management personnel with all levels of experience will benefit from this session.

Special Instructions: Registration is required. Due to space limitations, registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. This session is being held in a Federal facility. Attendees will be required to go through on-site security screening before being granted access to the facility. The on-site security screening is similar to airport screening. Attendees must provide a valid, government-issued photo ID and a copy of their registration confirmation. Please allow ample time for this security screening when planning your arrival.
