Register Now for the Loan Review System Live Webinar on June 28 Best Practices and Common Questions

With the successful implementation of the Loan Review System (LRS) on May 15, 2017, Federal Housing Administration (FHA)-approved lenders are now using the system for most Title II Single Family quality control functions. As part of its continuing commitment to ensure a successful transition, FHA is hosting a live webinar on Wednesday, June 28, 2017, to describe best practices and address common questions that lenders have about LRS.
