Claims Without Conveyance of Title (CWCOT) program in which the mortgagee attempts to secure a third-party purchaser for the mortgaged property so that conveyance to HUD is not required in exchange for mortgage insurance benefits. Topics include: how foreclosing on FHA properties may differ from previous guidelines; requirements for appraisals; bidding instructions; and claim requirements. The target audience is FHA-approved mortgagees (foreclosure valuation, claims, and default reporting personnel) and vendors that might be involved (real
