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1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

1 GENERAL INFORMATION

This documentation explains the process for incorporating data from Financial Assessment Subsystem – Public Housing (FASS-PH) eXtensible Markup Language (XML) Schema into FASS submissions. It also provides information related to the architecture of the schema. The schema is created in compliance with the FASS-PH business rules for unaudited submissions. Its purpose is for the creation of XML-based instance documents that generate the Public Housing Authorities (PHAs) unaudited financial submissions according to the Real Estate Assessment Center (REAC) FASS-PH business rules.

This document is intended to serve as a **supplement to the External User Manual for FASS-PH Release 9.2.5.0** to help guide users knowledgeable in XML to upload data via XML schema. It is intended to provide useful information related to the FASS-PH XML Schema and detail the processes for incorporating that data into FASS submissions.

The purpose of the FASS-PH XML Schema is to provide a specific framework and relationships that allow for exchanging data between the PHA's software application and REAC in accordance with existing FASS-PH business rules. The FASS-PH XML Schema does not set accounting and/or reporting standards.

The general process of using the XML Interface to submit unaudited financial data is as follows:

1. PHAs use their selected applications to gather financial data for REAC.
2. Using the FASS-PH XML Schema as a guideline, users already familiar with XML convert their financial data from the format in the selected applications to the XML format.
3. Users begin a submission in the same way as users not using XML data.
4. Users upload the XML data which flows into the various forms and data fields in the system.
5. If users receive a confirmation message, users save, validate, and submit their submissions in the same way as users not using XML data.
6. If errors are received, the user deletes the submission, corrects the data, and creates a new submission by following the above steps 2 – 5.

1.3 Data Flows

FASS-PH uses the XML Interface as one of the means to electronically capture and process financial information. The following are the current data flows involved in submitting an unaudited submission via the FASS-PH XML Interface:

- PHAs enter/update financial information in their native applications;
- PHAs use the FASS-PH XML Schema as a guideline to convert data into the FASS-PH XML format;
- FASS-PH validates data against the XML schema and, if valid, uploads it into the REAC database;
- FASS-PH displays the upload error or success message to the PHA users;
- PHAs validate programs/performance submission completeness checks using the FASS-PH Interface;
- PHAs submit submissions in FASS-PH.

2.0 GETTING STARTED

2 GETTING STARTED

2.1 Following the External User Manual

The FASS External User Manual, available from links located on the HUB REAC website at http://www.hud.gov/offices/reac/products/fass/pha_doc.cfm, is the guide for all aspects of creating and managing submissions, saving, validating, and submitting data, and reporting data in FASS. In all aspects of manipulating, reporting, and finalizing your submissions, you are required to follow the same procedures as though you entered data directly into the Financial Data Schedule and the Data Collection Form through the FASS screen by screen interface.

In doing so, almost all steps in the submission process will be described and detailed in the External User Manual. The only steps described in this manual will be those directly related to the upload of data through the XML interface.

2.1.1 Sequence of Activities

The sequence of activities from the beginning of creating a submission to the end of actually submitting is the same for XML Upload users and non-XML upload users with the exception of selecting your programs and actually populating the data fields in the FDS and DCF.

Below are the two sequences of events listed side by side to help you with a comparison.

2.1.2 Function of the XML Interface

The function of the XML interface in this release has changed to function only as the method for entering data into the Financial Data Schedule and the Data Collection Form. In prior releases, the XML interface performed additional functions, data checks, and validations that are no longer undertaken by the XML interface in this release. The goal is to simplify the XML upload process for users and to consolidate processes to help ensure consistent behavior by the system and consistent data population into forms by users.

2.2 Financial and Key Data Collection using XML

2.2.1 Entering Data into FDS and DCF

- Using XML, data may be uploaded into the following areas: Financial Data Schedule
 - All Projects
 - Balance Sheet
 - Income Statements
 - Elimination
 - COCC
 - All Programs
 - Balance Sheet
 - Income Statement
 - Elimination
 - COCC
- Data Collection Form
 - General Information
 - PHA Information
 - Programs selected

To upload data into these areas, the FASS-PH XML Schema must be followed exactly. Users intending to avail themselves of the XML upload functions must have an extensive familiarity with XML functionality and adhere to the structures and schema required for successful data upload.

These schema are detailed in Section 7.2: Sample XML Schema and can be downloaded from the HUD REAC website at http://www.hud.gov/offices/reac/products/fass/xml_pha.cfm

To execute an XML upload, your XML data file must follow the correct schema, hold the necessary data, and be located in a folder to which you have access and can navigate.

Prior to beginning the steps to upload your data as outlined below, be certain those criteria have been met. Without meeting those requirements in advance of attempting the upload of your data, you cannot achieve a successful submission.

It is important to note:

After you have populated the data fields in FDS and DCF using the XML upload interface, you must use the same processes to finalize the data that are used by PHAs not using XML to populate the data

fields. Specific instructions for doing so are provided in the External User Manual. In doing so, you

- must:

SAVE your data at the bottom of each page:

- Balance Sheet page
- Income Statement page
- Elimination page
- COCC page
- Details links pages within each of those pages and
- ○ DCF General Information form

VALIDATE your data at the bottom of each

- Income Statement page (when the Validation button becomes available) and
- DCF (when the Validation button becomes available).

2.3 Downloading XML Schema

All XML Schema are available on the HUD REAC website.

A full example containing elements for Program, Project, Balance Sheet, Income Statement, COCC, Elimination, Housing Choice Voucher Program, and Data Collection form is provided in Section 7.2 of this manual.

2.4 Determining Which Schema to Use

Below is a series of examples depicting the beginning lines of sections in the XML data that identify key components of each submission. There are intended to provide guidance. A full sample of an XML data file is located in Section 7.2 of this manual

2.4.1 Projects

The project must be identified in the XML document, as shown below, by placing the Project ID for the project in the location in bold face type below. The Project ID is available from the PIC System. The example below depicts the beginning of the Balance Sheet section of the XML data. In examples farther along in this section, ending tags for the XML file are also shown. For a comprehensive example, refer to Section 7.2 in this manual.

For the project Income Statement, in most cases, you will have two programs: Operating Fund (14.850) and Capital Fund (14.872). The beginnings of these sections are depicted below.

2.4.2 Programs

PHAs with funding from non-Asset Management programs (other than Capital Fund and Operating Subsidy)

The program must be identified in the XML document as shown below, by placing the CFDA# for the program in the location in bold face type below. The beginning and the ending of the Program elements are shown below. Notice the example of the end of Detail link data for Line Item # 355.

2.4.3 Housing Choice Voucher

This involves PHAs operating Section 8 programs. Many PHAs with Section 8 funds have this program.

The Housing Choice Voucher program must be identified in the XML document as shown below, by placing the CFDA# for the Housing Choice Voucher program in the location in bold face type below. Housing Choice Voucher Detail Links 11170 and 11180 can be populated in the XML document or populated after the XML upload through the on-line system interface. An example of the beginning and end of the Housing Choice voucher program elements are depicted below. Notice the example of the end of Detail link data for Line Item # 11190.

3 BUILDING YOUR SUBMISSION

3.1 Creating a Financial Submission

The steps of Creating a Draft Submission for an PHA using the

- XML Upload process are identical to that of PHAs not
- using the XML Upload process. You must:
Go to My Inbox to Create Submission
Enter your PHA Information on the first screen asking for:
 - Reporting Ending Date
 - Submission Type
 - Asset Management, and
 - Component Unit Then click

Details for these steps are provided in the External User Manual.

3.2 Differences for the XML Upload Process

3.2.1 Submission Type

PHAs using the XML data upload interface are limited to unaudited submissions. No audited submissions may be made with XML upload.

Select a radio button from one of the three submission types available for XML data submissions

- ☐ Unaudited/No Audit

3.2.2 Selecting Programs for the PHA

PHAs using the XML upload interface provide ALL information regarding their programs and projects through the XML data. PHAs intending to use the XML upload interface to populate the FDS and DCF data cannot select programs on the Program Selection page nor through the Add Programs menus.

Please Note:

DO NOT click the SAVE button on the Program Selection page, If you do, you will no longer be able to access the XML Upload interface.

4.0 PROVIDING THE FASS-PH XML SCHEMA

4 PROVIDING THE FASS-PH XML SCHEMA

4.1 Overview of FASS-PH XML Schema

The following is an overview of the FASS-PH XML Schema. It is assumed that the reader is familiar with FASS-PH online system and submission process and has a basic understanding of XML.

A list of all Item Numbers for FDS and DCF pages and Details links is provided in Appendix B. The Item Numbers are also available in the Business Rules appendix of the External User Manual.

4.1.1 Terminology

The terminology used in this schema frequently overlaps with terminology from other applications. The following short list is provided to reduce the possibility of ambiguity and confusion.

| Term | Definition |
|-----------------------|---|
| Schema | An XML Schema defines elements, each corresponding to a concept that can be referenced. The FASS-PH XML Schema can be regarded as extensions of the XML Schema. It defines unaudited financial elements that correspond to the FASS-PH unaudited financial submission business rules. |
| Instance document | An XML document containing FASS-PH XML elements. The PHA FASS-PH submission expressed in FASS-PH XML would be an instance document. |
| Element | An XML element is a "fact," or piece of information, described by this FASS-PH XML Schema. For example, —reportingPeriodTol is an element. |
| Structure | Structures are collections of one or more elements of an arbitrary type. |
| Camel case convention | An XML naming convention that capitalizes the first character of each word except the first word. |

4.1.2 FASS-PH XML Schema Sections

The schema contains several sections that correspond to typical FASS-PH submission components. While there is no true concept of "sections" in the schema, it is helpful to view it in these artificial groups in order to better understand the schema. Each section is defined as a child of the root schema element named "FASPHASubmission". The following is a listing of sections and a brief explanation of those sections:

| Section | Filename | Description |
|--|------------------------|---|
| Main | FASPHA.xsd | This section contains key elements that make up a valid unaudited submission. For example, the PHA Code, the reporting period from, the reporting period to, the submission type, and the program list are all key elements. |
| Data Collection Form (DCF) Line Items | FASPHA_DCF.xsd | This section contains information that defines DCF line items. For example, the name of the line item, allowed values that can be selected for that line item and the associated data types. |
| Financial Data Schedule (FDS) Line Items | FASPHA_FDS.xsd | This section contains information that defines FDS line items. For example, the name of the line item, allowed values that can be selected for that line item, data type, zero allowed, negative allowed, positive only, and negative only. |
| Balance Sheet Line Items | FASPHA_bslineitems.xsd | This section contains DCF information, such as the line items for "Unaudited/A-133" as well as whether they are mandatory or optional. |
| Income Statement Line Items | FASPHA_islineitems.xsd | This section contains FDS information for any program filed under the Full Accrual / Post GASB 34 accounting method. For example, the line items for program "Development" and whether they are mandatory or optional. |

4.1.3 Element Names

Element names are created using camel case conventions.

Each element name used is similar to its counterpart in the FASS-PH online Interface. For line items, the line item number is used instead of the text. For example, line item 11210 is named lineItem11210, not unitMonthsLeased. If a line item has details, then ".detail" is added to the name. Hyphens are not allowed when naming an element. Instead, a period is used. For example, lineItem11180.010 is the name of the detail line item 11180-010.

There are almost 1500 different programs present in the REACS database. Instead of defining a program type for each of the programs, general program types were created. Their names consist of two parts separated by a period. The first part of each program type name is the accounting method. The second part is a letter (A, B, C, D) or a phrase (generalSimple, generalD, generalE).

4.1.4 Schema Elements Included

The schema includes all fields on the PHA Info page, the DCF pages, and the FDS pages that users use for data entry.

4.1.5 How Elements were Derived

Elements were derived from the current FASS-PH online Interface. All elements that require user input were selected. All elements such as G9100-011 (Entity Name) were ignored. All computed elements such as 190 (Total Assets) were also ignored. Existing FASS-PH business rules were used to determine each selected element's constraints.

5 SUBMISSION TYPES SECTION 5.1

The Submission Type Structure

5.1.1 Scope

Only unaudited submission types are defined. The audited submission types in the current FASS-PH Web Interface are not supported by the FASS-PH XML Interface.

5.1.2 Structure

An annotated example of the structure of an acceptable XML file is provided in Section 13.1 Appendix A of this XML User Manual.

6.0 PROGRAM TYPES SECTION

6 PROGRAM TYPES SECTION

6.1 The Program Types

6.1.1 Scope

The XML upload method for populating data in the FDS and DCF pages is effective for the federal programs users will find on the Program Selection page in the FASS-PH Interface. A unique program type is defined if a program requires a unique set of FDS line items. A general program is defined when several programs share the same set of FDS line items. It is the responsibility of the user to select the correct program type.

6.1.2 Program Types for XML Upload

The XML Upload method is available only for federal programs listed below utilizing the Full Accrual accounting method.
