Daniel (44) and Katheryn (40) Barnes are the proud recipients of HOME funds administered through the First Tennessee Development District (FTDD). The Barnes' are lifelong residents of Greene County. Daniel has mobility issues and has been disabled since



his leg was removed. Daniel loves the outdoors and working outside, but with his disability he has been unable to successfully take care of their home. Daniel saw a public notice in the paper about the HOME funds, so the Barnes went to the public hearing, filled out the paper work and hoped for the best. With the HOME funds, FTDD was able to make repairs to the Barnes' home by replacing the heat pump, the roof, the exterior doors and the deck. On the inside there were plumbing and bathroom repairs made.

Daniel and Katheryn both love taking care of their pets and Daniel spends a lot of time watching Nascar racing and hunting. "Getting our home repaired is such a blessing, especially with the new deck, I can spend more time sitting outside admiring the beautiful view," said Daniel.

## About the HOME Program

THDA administers the federally funded HOME Program to promote the production, preservation and rehabilitation of housing for low income households. HOME Grants are awarded annually through a competitive application process to cities, counties and non-profit organizations outside the local participating jurisdictions. Community housing development organizations (CHDOs) are eligible to apply for THDA HOME Grants, only if the proposed project is outside most HOME local participating jurisdictions.
