On September 13, 2013, HUD published a rule in the Federal Register inviting public comment on proposed changes to the Housing Counseling Program regulations for the purpose of implementing the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act amendments to the housing counseling statute. Housing Counseling Program New Certification Requirements: The Housing Counseling Program proposed rule, Housing Counseling Program: New

Certification Requirements was published in the Federal Register on Friday, September 13, 2013. The proposed rule makes changes to HUD's Housing Counseling Program that were required by the Dodd-Frank Act enacted into law on July 21, 2010. It describes new certification requirements for the Housing Counseling Program as well as other important changes, and invites interested persons to submit comments about the proposed rule. We will discuss highlights of the proposed rule and how to submit comments.

FHA Mortgagee Letter 2013-26 - Back to Work: As part of an ongoing effort to expand access to mortgage credit for families impacted by the recent financial crisis, FHA is providing guidance for underwriting borrowers credit who, but for economic circumstances brought on by the crisis, would be creditworthy. These policy announcements provide greater clarity and flexibility to lenders encouraging them to consider additional factors when evaluating a borrower's credit, ultimately supporting the recovery of the housing market and the economy. All applicants for this program must complete pre-purchase counseling from a HUD-approved housing counseling agency at least 30 days prior to submitting their application for a loan. During this call we will discuss housing counseling requirements for this program.

Additionally, HUD's Office of Housing Counseling presenters fielded questions from the audience and provided responses.
