Loan Review System Implementation and Process Changes

Today, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) published <u>Mortgagee Letter 2017-03</u>, *FHA Loan Review System – Implementation and Process Changes*. This Mortgagee Letter announces FHA's intention to implement its new Loan Review System, which will provide an electronic platform for FHA loan-level file reviews and other quality control functions for Title II Single Family mortgages. The system implementation date will be confirmed in a subsequent Mortgagee Letter.

The Loan Quality Assessment Methodology (Defect Taxonomy) communicated in June 2015 will be implemented within the Loan Review System, as will several functions that are currently performed in other FHA systems or require manual processes. Overall, the Loan Review System will streamline and enhance many quality control processes for both mortgagees and FHA.

Today's Mortgagee Letter is the first in a series of communications to be issued in the coming months to assist mortgagees in preparing to use the Loan Review System. Mortgagees are encouraged to participate in the January 26, 2017, Loan Review System live webinar. Details and the registration link to participate are included at the end of this *FHA INFO*.

Single Family Housing Policy Handbook 4000.1 (SF Handbook) change pages reflecting the implementation of the Loan Review System are included in Mortgagee Letter 2017-03, and will be incorporated into the PDF and online SF Handbook in a future quarterly update.

Loan Review System Live Webinar

This is the first in a planned series of webinars for mortgagees that will be held over the coming months.
